THE PROJECT.

This project will be carried out in the Home Host Happy Faces "Infant Jesus of Prague" in the town of Lurin - Lima, home to 45 girls between 3 to 15 years of age who have been victims of sexual and physical abuse

In this project the young volunteer will implement its high sense of service, strengthening the shortcomings of values, self esteem, and desire to overcome in girls and teenagers, through games, dynamic educational lectures, strengthening schools, to arouse the interest of the minors.

All the girls need the voluntary affection, interest and much enthusiasm. Depending on the situation need to live, we will have to help them return to trust the "biggest" catch up at school to learn to play and interact with other children. In sum, offer a way out of his troubled personal situation.

OBJECTIVE:

The project aims to strengthen and promote the comprehensive development of children and adolescents at risk, conducting educational workshops and recreational resources to be able to overcome the consequences of violence that have lived in their homes.

ACTIVITIES

The group of volunteers will conduct various activities, according to their skills, experiences and interests, and the performance of the program activities of the institution, for example:

- Academic activities, such as the strengthening of some educational materials and teaching computer skills.
- Implement and develop various workshops with the girls to their initiative and creativity.
- Support in the workshops of couture, weaving, painting and other
- Sports activities
- Recreational activities. As music, dance, crafts.

Mato is located 2.239 m.s.n.m; Mato District is located in central-western province of Huaylas, Cordillera Negra in the Alley on the left of the River Santa. the climate is mild and healthy.

INFORMATION ABOUT CAJAMARCA - CUMBICO

The project will take place at the Cumbico Rural Community, close to the city of Cajamarca (about 2 hours by bus). In this rural area, people live from agriculture and cattle herding.

Cajamarca, the capital of Peruvian Carnival, it is not only famous for that great party celebrated every year in February but also for its cultural richness that was kept through centuries, this in great part due to the identity that the Andean people could maintain thanks to th traditional activities developed in this region – from working the land to the way of celebrating any traditional festivity.

In this new world linked by new ways of communicating that have raised in the human being a greater curiosity about old traditions spread throughout the globe, Cajamarca is an appropriate place to stop and share with the world its ancient ways that are still so much alive.

In this sense the great potential of this region of Peru has been spotted by people from other parts of the world who are eager to know it, thus opening a chance to the set up of residential tourism which could in some way benefit the communities that could host this activity.

PROJECT'S DETAILS:

“Cumbico Rural Community”

The project will consist in allowing both the international volunteers as well as the members of the rural community to share the traditional ways of the Andean Peruvian communities thus enriching their lives. It is our hope that they can, by doing so, reach a sense of equality amongst all those involved in this project – the members of the rural community, the international volunteers, those responsible for the project and the local authorities.

- Picking and sowing green vegetables and root vegetables

DESCRIPTION OF CAJAMARCA CITY

The department of Cajamarca is located in the area norteandina presents sierra and jungle areas. Bordered to the north with Ecuador, to the south with La Libertad, on the west, Piura, Lambayeque and La Libertad and the east by Amazon. Its capital Cajamarca is a city located in the inter-valley of the same name, the city you can see from the Santa Apolonia hill. Cajamarca is now the core economic, tourist, industrial, commercial, cultural and mining the mountains of northern Peru.

Height of the capital: 2.720 meters.

Climate: Cajamarca by the altitude is in the Quechua region (between 2300-3500 m) which determines its climate is temperate, dry, sunny day but cold at night. Its average annual temperature is 15.6 ° C, being the rainy season from December to March, matching the cyclical El Niño phenomenon, typical of the tropical northern Peru. However, in its various regions, some cities have a tropical climate. Besides the proximity to both the Coast and into the jungle, not to mention its proximity to the equator, makes it have the best climate in the cities of the Peruvian Sierra. You do not have snow-capped peaks, but with moist subtropical forest to the eastern slopes, subtropical and tropical dry towards the western side, where the department saw the highest rate of afforestation

INFORMATION ABOUT TOCLLA - HUARAZ CITY:

Huaraz is located in the central-northern part of the country at an altitude of 3052 m, some 420 km north of Lima. Huaraz sits in the agriculturally important Callejón de Huaylas valley, at the foot of the Cordillera Blanca mountain range, which includes Huascarán, the highest mountain in Peru at 6768 m.

Toclla is located 3052 m.s.n.m; Toclla District is located in central-western province of Huaylas, Cordillera Negra in the Alley on the left of the River Santa. the climate is mild and healthy.

WORKCAMP'S DETAILS

CULTURAL EXCHANGE PROJECT IN TOCLLA – HUARAZ ANCASH

The Project will let you to develop an approaching of vivential knowledgments of rural life in the highlands of Peru. During the development of the project, volunteers will be in frequent contact with the geography and Andean demography, developing communal work with people from the community, children, youth and adults in typical community tasks.

ACTIVITIES:

- To teach youth and children the language you speak (English, French among others) as well as to learn the native language of Peru: Quechua.
- To participate in daily tasks with familias (sowing, harvesting, irrigation building houses, etc)
- To participate in the activities of the community (communal tasks, patronal festivities among others).
- Participate in the improvement of the economic activities of the community (agriculture, irrigation systems, etc.).

TO REALIZE DIFERENT ACTIVITIES WE WANT YOU TO BRING:

- Sport and flighty clothes, flashlights, sunglasses, caps, waterproof clothes
- Materials that can useful to camp work (leather boots, gloves, creams that protect from the sun and flies).
- To **camp activities**: bring materials accroding to your abilities, experices or interests..
- **Photos** of your country, family, city to show and interchange with the volunteers and people from the city.
- Some typical food´s recipe of your country to cook together.
- Food, sweet things, chocolates, drinks and other things of your country to share in the integration´s nights.
- CDs, musical instruments, presentation of your country or any other things that you want to share with the group of volunteers in the world.

ACOMMODATION:

All volunteers will stay in a house in the community. It is important to mention that every volunteer should bring a sleeping bag and if it is possible an air bed and/or a rubber one.

FOOD:

It will be cooked by a person from the community in the coexistence place, different and typical plates from the city.

HEALTH INSURANCE: Every volunteer should have a health and life insurance as well as the necessary vaccinations.

MEETING POINTS

ARRIVING DATES TO PERU:

Every volunteer should arrive to Lima on August 03, 2009. The international flights arrive to Jorge Chavez Airport during the whole day and night.

The time between the airport to Lima is about 30 minutes in automovil. The taxi´s service is informal, so you have to be careful in the moment you take one. The cost is about USD 15.00 o EUR 12.00.

In Lima, there are hotels of many categories but there are hostelling to young people that are cheap, located in the Historical Center of Lima.

It's important to change your money in the airport Jorge Chavez.

The volunteers should confirm by e-mail in what flight they are arriving to Peru, day and hour.

ADDITIONAL

The volunteers who want to be received in the airport Jorge Chavez can coordinate with us. The additional cost is EUR 25.00 or USD 30.00 that considers:

- To move from the airport to a hotel in Lima.
- Cost of a hotel for one night.
- To move from the hotel to the bus stop in Lima to travel to Huaraz City.

ARRIVING DATE TO HUARAZ

During the whole day on August 04, every volunteer should arrive to Huaraz City. The time of the trip from Lima to Huaraz is 7 hours.

There are many autobuses services, we recommend the bed-bus service, they are comfortable, they have food and drink service and the personal attention in the bus. The cost of the ticket from Lima to Huaraz is 50 or 55 soles that are USD 20.00 ó EUR 13.00. The buses work by the mornings and nights.

By the morning, the buses leave at 8:00 am until 13:00 hrs and arrive to Huaraz at 6:00 pm of the same day.

By the night, the buses leave from Lima at 22:00 pm until 23:00 pm and arrive to Huaraz at 5:30 until 7:00 am of the next day.

In the moment of your arriving, volunteers of our association will wait in the bus stop to go to the accommodation place.

Jorge Galiano will carry out with the guide, coordinator and facilitator functions in Lima City, in order you can walk with security in this city and take the right bus to Huaraz. The expenses in Lima City, the taxi and bus's tickets will be paid by every volunteer. **If you decide stay one night in Lima, it will be a coordination work with Jorge and the expenses of accommodation will be paid by the volunteers.**

Language: the official peruvian language is Spanish. There are local languages like quechua but all peruvians speak a perfect spanish. In Lima City many people speak in English because of the activities they develop.

Change and cost in Huaraz: U\$S 1.00 = S/ 2.80 (nuevos soles). EUR 1.00 = S/ 3.75 (nuevos soles). Cost of a urban ticket: S/ 2.50 (nuevos soles), interprovincial to go to Huaraz: S/ 50.00 ó S/: 55.00 (nuevos soles), a soda or water S/. 1.5 (nuevos soles), a beer ½ liter S/ 3.00 (nuevos soles), a dinner in a restaurant S/ 10.00 (nuevos soles), hotel, sharing room by night S/ 40.00 (nuevos soles).
